## California Voluntary Carbon Market Disclosures Act (AB 1305) Information

A. O. Smith Corporation (“A. O. Smith”) provides the below information relating to Section 44475 of Division 26, Part 10 of the California Health and Safety Code (“Code”) added by California Assembly Bill 1305, the Voluntary Carbon Market Disclosures Act.

### Emissions and Claims Information (Section 44475.2)

A. O. Smith has a greenhouse gas (“GHG”) emissions reduction goal of 10% GHG Emissions Intensity (Metric Tons CO<sub>2e</sub>/\$MM rev)<sup>1</sup> by 2025 (2019 baseline). In 2024, the company surpassed its 2025 greenhouse gas emissions reduction goal by 20%.<sup>2</sup> Additional details as required by AB 1305 may be found on the Environment, Social, and Governance (ESG) webpage, the [A.
